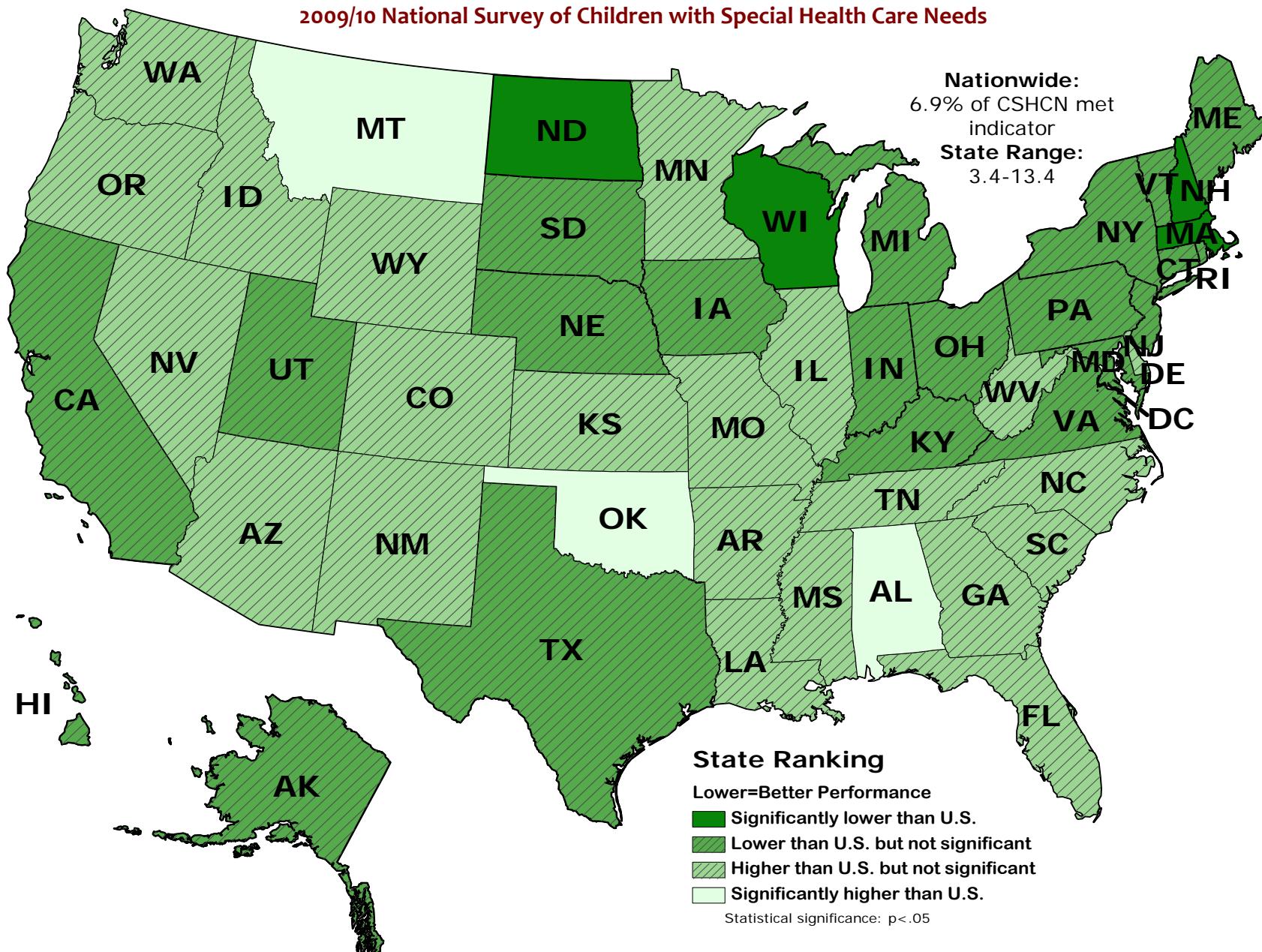


Indicator 10: CSHCN without any personal doctor or nurse
