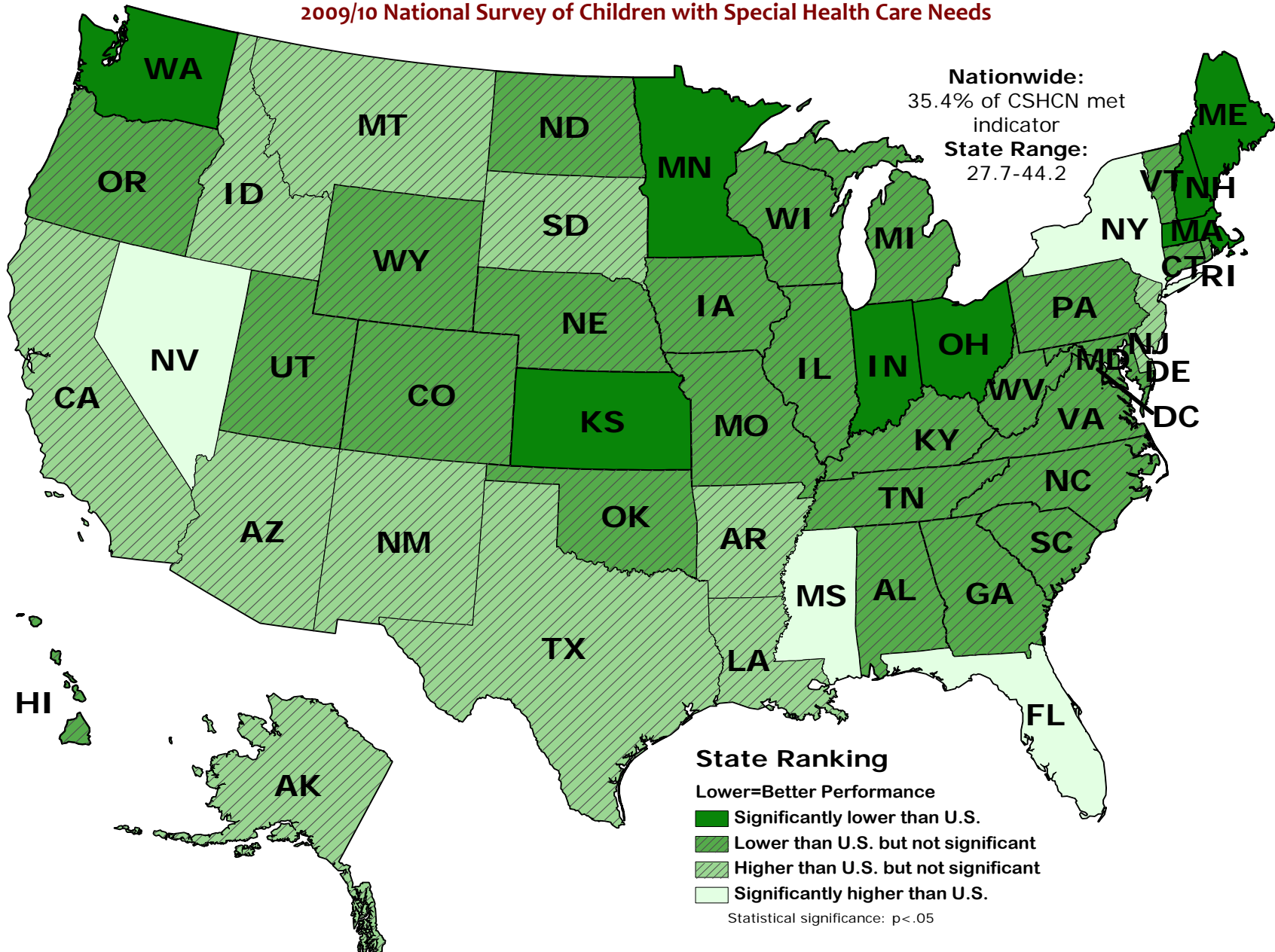


Indicator 11: CSHCN without family-centered care
