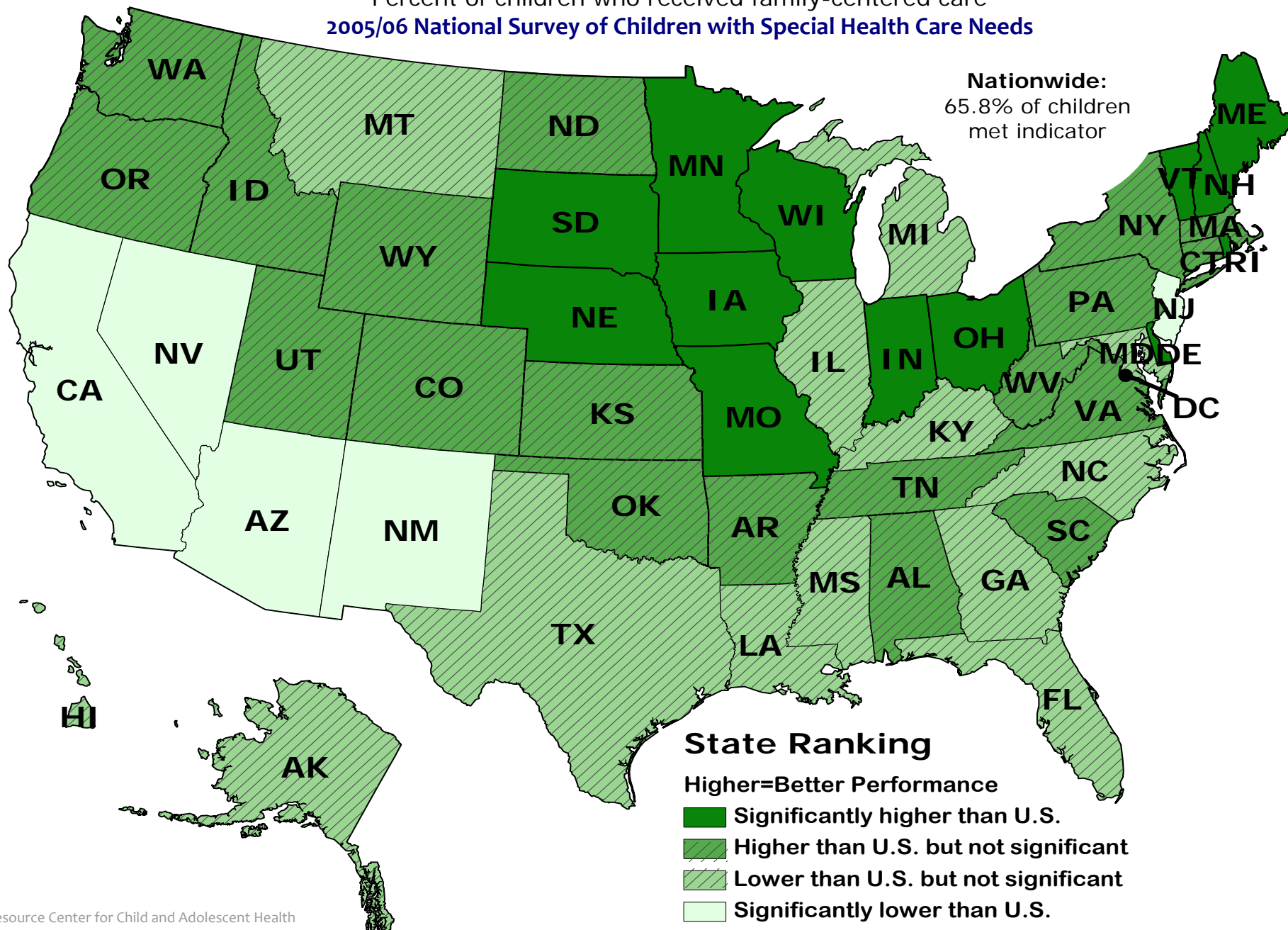


Medical Home Component – Family-Centered Care
