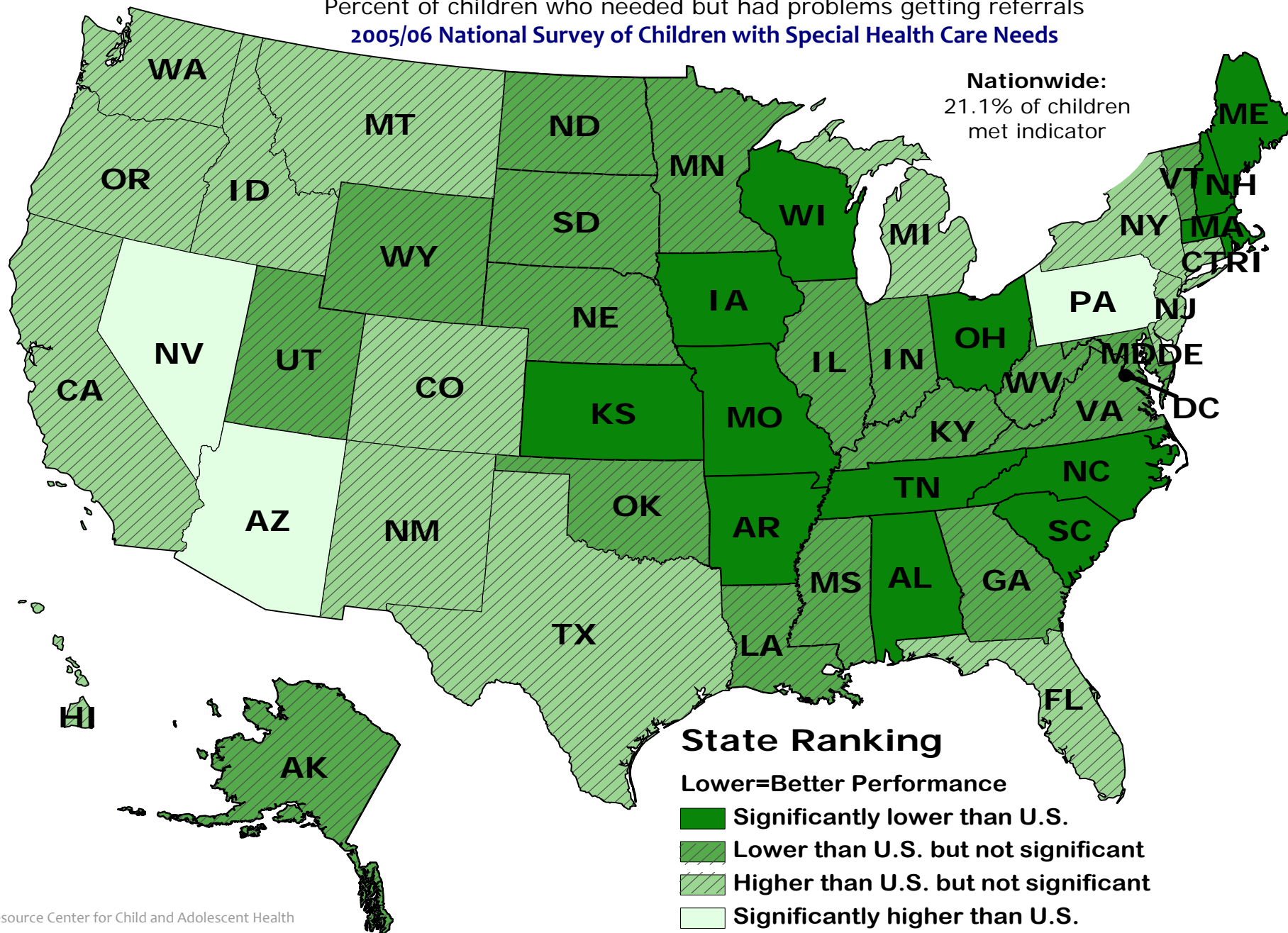


Medical Home Component – Problems Getting Referrals
